2009 Federal Grant Funding for SERTC Training Awarded

July 7, 2009, Pueblo, CO –Formal notice from the Department of Homeland Security on TTCI’s successful grant application and award for security and emergency response training provides almost \$5 million of Homeland Security National Training Program funds to support state, local, and tribal first responders to attend classes at the SERTC campus through May 2010.

TTCI now joins the other six members of an elite consortium, actively providing world class training in emergency response to the Nation's public safety response communities. This award places TTCI in an excellent position to continue with a similar award in 2010.
