TO: Members and Private Car Owners

Gentlemen:

The Mechanical Division of the Association of American Railroads herein provides additional details concerning the continuing implementation of the Quality Assurance Program. As you will recall, the implementation of the program was originally announced in circular letter c-7081 dated September 10, 1985 and further explained in circular letter c-7149 dated November 10, 1986.

Contractors (as defined in M-1003) of components in Group C-2 only are herein invited to advise the Director-Technical Committees in writing of their intent to make application for Quality Assurance Certification under the provisions of Specification M-1003 by August 31, 1987. Group C-2 components include: reconditioned draft gears and reconditioned cushioning devices.

Upon receipt of a letter of intent, an appplication form and additional information concerning the certification process will be provided to each potential applicant. Contractors filing formal applications accompanied by payment of the initial \$500.00 fee by October 31, 1987 will be assured common group status; that is, certification will be awarded to qualifying contractors in that group simultaneously, provided all necessary information is furnished by the applicant in a timely fashion.

Schedules for Group D will be developed as the program progresses and circular letter notice will be given well in advance of application deadline dates.

Your support and cooperation will be sincerely appreciated.
